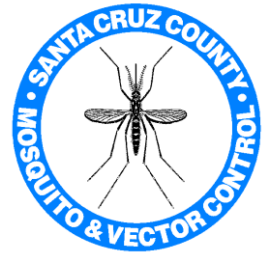

County of Santa Cruz (Agricultural Commissioner Department – Mosquito and Vector Control division) Notice of Intent to continue to apply aquatic mosquitocides for public health purposes as part of the Integrated Vector Management program.

To Whom It May Concern:

As of October 31, 2011, the Santa Cruz County Mosquito Abatement and Vector Control (MAVC) applied for coverage and was subject to the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit (Water Quality Order No. 2012-0003-DWQ, amending No. 2011-0002-DWQ, General Permit No. CAG 990004) adopted on March 1, 2011 by the State Water Resources Control Board. The Permit requires that the MAVC provide an annual notice of our intent to discharge pesticides to potentially affected governmental agencies. Notice is hereby given that the MAVC intends to continue to

perform public health mosquitocide applications as part of its ongoing operations under its Integrated Vector Management program.

The MAVC's activities are conducted year-round within the four cities and unincorporated areas of the County on properties under various jurisdictions such as listed above. The MAVC typically uses larvicide applications for the purpose of reducing mosquitoes in an effort to reduce nuisance and the threat of mosquito-borne diseases. When surveillance indicators exceed threshold levels larvicide applications may be made in strict compliance with pesticide label requirements. These larvicides are described as bacterial products, insect growth regulators and larvicidal oils. In addition to the larvicides, the County's mosquito-borne disease response plan allows for the potential use of adulticides if necessary in an emergency public health situation.

Mosquito breeding sources treated with mosquitocides used by the MAVC require no additional restrictions or precautions to be taken by your employees or the public. The following materials may be used:
