INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION FEE INCREASES FOR FY 18/19

Effective July 1, 2018, fees for inspection and certification services will be increased. The adjustments will result in increases to phytosanitary certificate fees and inspection service fees during regular business hours and after business hours. Preparation of phytosanitary certificates (including Certificates of Quarantine Compliance) and inspection services will be charged following the new fees below. The increases will help to recover the cost to provide and deliver these important services.
